Qualified applicants must possess a high school diploma or GED; have at least one-year experience in an institutional kitchen setting or one year of related schooling. Experience working with the School Lunch Program is preferred. Long periods of standing are required as well as the ability to lift a minimum of 20 pounds. Workweek will consist of a rotating 40 hour a week schedule. Must be able to work weekends and holidays. 21 years of age or older. No criminal record.
